I am thrilled and honored to be able to share in our 7th and 8th grader's faith journey this school year! This is a journey that I walk *with* the parents of these young men and women. We are using a Religion series this year published by RCL called Faith First. In 7th grade we will be covering two books in this series starting with Church and Sacraments followed by the first part of Church History. The 8th grade will begin with Church History and then we will learn about Jesus and the New Testament. RCL offers a wonderful website at www.faithfirst.com. When you reach the website, it will ask you what series. Click on "Legacy Edition". From there both the students and parents can access links with practice tests, games and activities, a parent's corner, and family activities. I will be requiring students to use this website to take an online practice test before our chapter tests this year. Students are welcome to take the practice test as many times as they like but need only email me **one test** for credit. They receive points for taking the test, **not** the score they have received. Here is the process for taking an online practice test:

1. go to the website www.faithfirst.com
2. on the left side click on **Teen Center**
3. click on **Chapter Reviews**
4. choose your edition - click on **Legacy Edition**
5. choose your grade:
 - 7th grade clicks on **Church and Sacraments**, then later this year, **Church History**
 - 8th grade clicks on **Church History**, then later this year, **Jesus and the New Testament**
6. choose your chapter - click on chapter
7. after the test, email the results to me : menos@stbernardine.org
8. be sure to include your name on the test so that I can credit you for taking the test
9. remember, you can take the test as many times as you like, but you need to email only **one** test to me
10. you receive points for taking the review, NOT for the score you receive
11. I will send you a confirmation that I have received your chapter review
